Praying For The zimpossible

NOTHING IS TO HARD FOR GOD

Praying for the impossible takes intention and it takes work, I know that your praying, But this type of prayer took me time to learn and I'm still learning more each time I do this prayer.

But when I used it with in 24 hours God had answered my prayer. I greatly recommend that once you start out that you do every thing in order. (1st) First by supplication, (2nd) second by prayer, (3rd) third by intercession and (4th) forth by giving of thanks.

Supplication is a petition, an entreaty or a humble request. , A legal side of the issue, it is acceptable, it has legal guidelines and is addressed to a legal authority and requires judicial actions to be taken.

Writing The Petition

Entreaty

A serious and intense request, Important not trivial. It stresses a need not a desire.

Its not just a passive prayer , But an intense prayer.

Effectual fervent prayer

An effectual fervent prayer is one that pushes for power and has an effect

Nothing Can Stop You

PRAYER IS POWERFUL

THE PERFECT 'WEAPON'

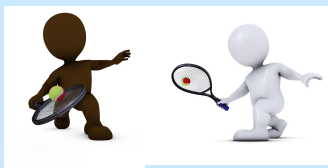






God is the Highest God.

carried out on the earth.

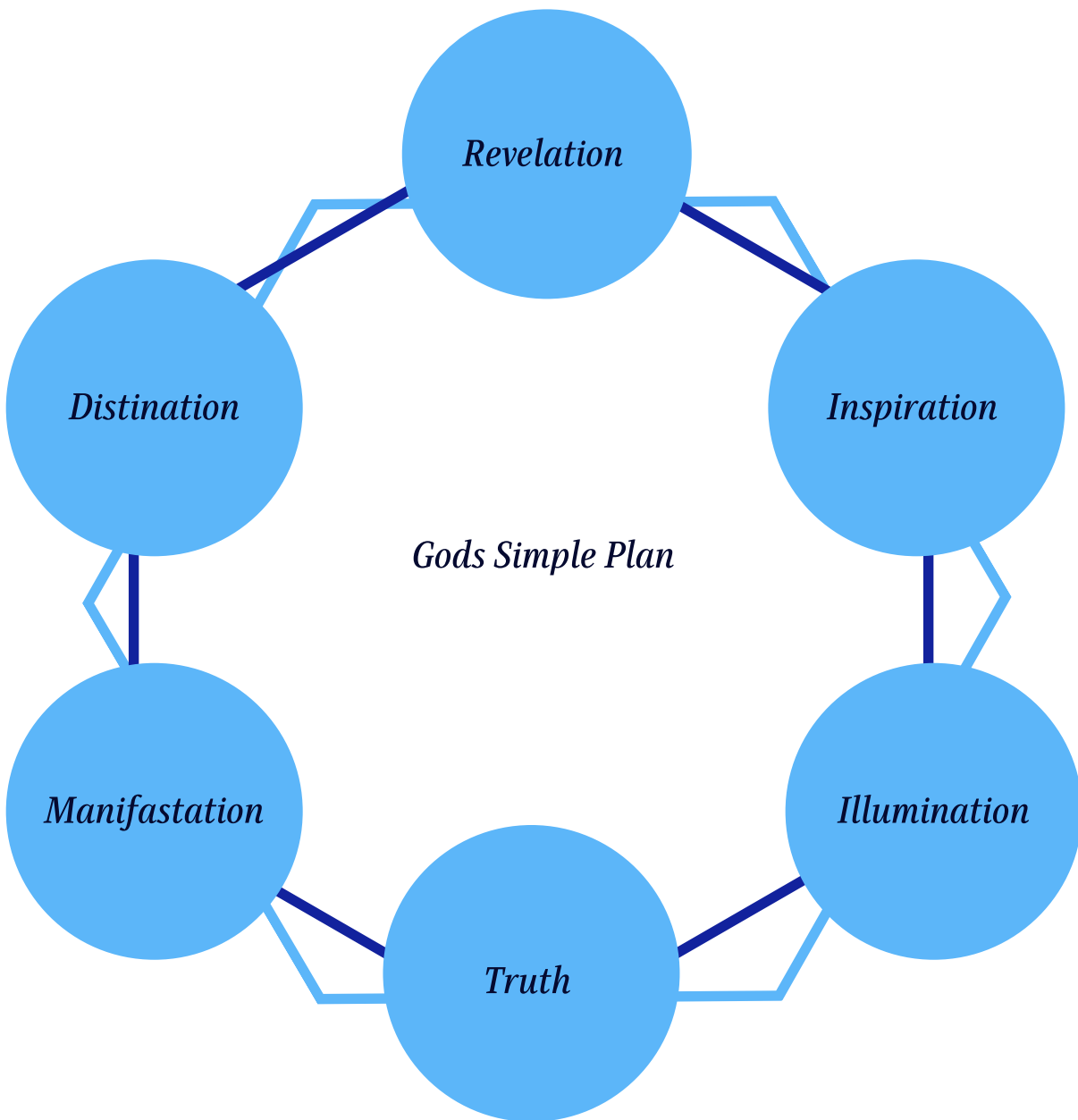
Knowing the will of God in a particular

From Heart To Heart



2015 October, I wrote down some things that I wanted to pray about, eight different things on my list,

First: I wanted to have better study habits with God.

Second: I asked for success for me in business.

Third: I wrote down I wanted a new home.

Forth: Lord, show me how to create better relationships within the family.

Fifth: Teach me to be better on the job with customers, workers, and supervisors

Sixth: Healing and a sound mind for my children, my sisters, and brothers.

Seventh: A successful Conference this year in October

Eighth: Peace with leaving the church for Willie and Dorothy.

Now here's the thing: making a list is great, but nothing happens if you don't do the petition.

What are you praying for? Make sure you explain it and make it clear in your mind, then get the petition written. I didn't write out my petition, So guess what? Nothing happened,

Now I will be writing a petition for a few of these; some things are under my control. I am asking for guidance on the rest of my requests.

Understanding The Meaning

In the Bible, we are told: "do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." (Philippians 4:6).

1

Supplication

We can define supplication as a form of a prayer, a call for help from God. The term bears a spirit of reverence and devotion with it, a solemn prayer to a higher power.

2

Request

Asking politely or formally for something. If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. Let your request be known.

3

Petition

a formal written request, typically one signed by many people, appealing to authority with respect to a particular cause.

4

Be Bold

God tells us to come boldly to the throne of grace that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in times of need. The Bible says in Hebrews 4: 16 if you do not know the will of God when it comes time to pray, then you will not receive or understand what God has in store for you.

5

Submit Yourself

When you submit to the known will of God, your emotions come under his control. Your mind can be selective in its thought process, and you can make better choices because the will of God is in the choices made and according to the Word of God.

6

A Sincere Prayer

James 4:3 says we ask and receive not because we asked a miss. When you can humble yourself by submitting your will to God's will, your prayers will come to pass because you prayed his will.

Your Formal Request Starts Here

God speaks to us, and we must listen. We must be obedient and swift to carry out what God asks us to do.

Once you understand how to write out the petition and appreciate the verses and the order of doing the petition, then God's will is understood, and you can begin teaching others how to write their petition out.

1

When you pray together, you contend with an adversary. The church strives together with Paul because he wrote down his prayers; they could agree to a greater degree and were confident that they were all on one accord.

2

United Prayer of this kind can be mighty; the place which the believers were standing on shook after they had prayed on one accord.

3

Paul's prayers worked because he wrote them down. God also heard David's supplication, and he answered. He will also answer you. He desires to work on your behalf. We must remember to write our request down once we see what the Scriptures are saying.

4

Paul asked the church to pray with him as he prayed for them. The key phrase here is. Strive together, which means to struggle in the company with others,

5

Don't pray and miss the mark because of wrong motives and wrong prayer, and even when you ask, you don't get it because your reasons are all wrong. You want what will give you pleasure.

6

The power was in the church because Paul wrote them letters. He wrote letters of supplications that he had written out, and the prayers he was praying for were added in.

Your Formal Request Continues

Our petition is a formal written request; it's written in a legal term that deals with the legal side of the issue. It follows legal guidelines and is addressed to an authoritative Figure who wants to take action on your behalf.

1

In this case, the authoritative figure that we're addressing is God. He is the supreme authority that we are writing to. This request is honest, serious, and intense. There's no joking or may be involved in this request. It's serious to us, and it's crucial and not trivial.

2

When writing this petition, All you're expressing is that there is a sense of need and not a desire or a want; we know that the effectual and fervent prayer of the righteous man availeth much.

3

The Bible says in Matthew 11:12 until now, the Kingdom of Heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force. In another understanding is, the kingdom of heaven has been subject to violence, and the violent lay claims to it.

4

God tells us to come boldly to the throne of grace that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in times of need. The Bible says in Hebrews 4: 16 if you do not know the will of God when it comes time to pray, then you will not receive or understand what God has in store for you.

5

Another way to say this is to Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence to receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

6

The struggle that we go through in prayer is accepting the will of God; sometimes, it's hard for us to pray and take how God wants to handle our situation. Occasionally, we have to pray about ourselves and accept his outcome, not ours.
