At the end of the day, it is important to lose our fear of praying "wrong." There is no wrong way to pray honestly. If you are being honest with God and honest with yourself, then you are praying correctly.

Overcoming The Impossible

When you know the will of God in a particular area, then you can also have faith in it. There are different types of prayer, and they each have guidelines.

- Prayer of faith: James 5:15 says, "And the prayer of faith will save the one who is sick."
- Prayer of agreement: (Acts 1:14), also known as corporate prayer.
- Prayer of request or supplication: We are to take our requests to God. (Philippians 4:6)
- prayer of thanksgiving: Focuses on what God has done. (Philippians 4:6)
- The prayer of worship: Focuses on who God is (Acts 13:2-3)
- The prayer of consecration: Sometimes, prayer is a time of setting ourselves apart to follow God's will(Matthew 26:39).
- The prayer of intercession: Our prayers often include requests for others as we intercede for them. (1 Timothy 2:1)
- The prayer of imprecation: They are used to invoke God's judgment on the wicked and thereby avenge the righteous. (Matthew 5:44-48.)
- Praying in the Spirit: The Spirit Himself makes intercession for us. (1 Corinthians 14:14-15)

God wants us to know what to pray for, whom to pray for, and how to pray.

Prayer of Worship

Hebrews 13:15
These prayers can be as simple as, "God, you're so good."
or as huge as in Revelation 4:11, "Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will, they existed and were created."

Prayer of Thanksgiving

Psalms 100:4
Praying our thankfulness to the One who gave us what we have in our lives is another way we can pray. It is closely related to a prayer of worship, although the difference is that one is recognizing who God is, and the other is giving thanks to God for what He has done.

Prayer of Faith

James 5:13-16
When we pray in faith, it is us reaffirming that we have faith in God's will. It isn't us enforcing our will into His, but it is us conceding that His will be done.
Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.

Prayer of Intercession

Daniel 9:1-27
Intercession is the act of praying on behalf of another person or group of people. When we pray for the well-being of others we are interceding on their behalf.
Daniel 9:1-27. Daniel goes to the Lord and intercedes on behalf of his people. We can also do this in our lives.

Corporate Prayer

Acts 12:5-18
Corporate prayer is praying in a group. This can bring a sense of unity and community to you and your fellow believers.
An example of this type of prayer is in Acts 12:5-18. In this passage, the church is praying for Peter's wellbeing.

Prayer of Consecration

Matthew 26:26-27
When we take communion, we are praying a prayer of consecration. This means we are consecrating the bread and wine God to make it holy
While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples

Prayer of the Holy Spirit

Romans 8:26-27
Sometimes we don't know what we want or need to pray for at any given time. The Spirit helps us in our weakness.
We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.

Prayer Blessings

1
Blessing & Adoration
In prayers of adoration we praise God and acknowledge our dependence on Him.

Prayer Petition

2
In prayers of petition we ask God for things we need both spiritually and physically.

Prayer Intercession

3
In prayers of intercession we make requests to God on behalf of other people.

Prayer Thanksgiving

4
Prayers of thanksgiving we thank God for the good things.

Prayer Praise & Worship

5
Praise
In prayers of praise we express our love for God, the source of all love.
Worship
Bow down to God, Express honor and glory to the Father in Spirit and in truth from the heart.

The prayer of supplication

The prayer of supplication is the kind of prayer that can be used in critical situations where there seems to be no other way.

When you know the will of God in a particular area, then you can also have faith for it.

Matthew 18:19 which says, 'if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing...'any thing concerning the two of you. Jesus affirms that He will be present in the midst

But, the situation has to concerns the two, but they both can intercede for each other.

Turned to First Timothy 2:1 which says, "I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made **"for all men."**

"We're dealing with four types of prayer here, but they're in an order."

The order is : first, supplications; second, prayers; third, intercessions; and fourth, the giving of thanks.

Although each of these four types of prayer also work alone, the words, first of all, spoke to me of a particular order.

They could be prayed collectively or individually, and they could be prayed multiple times. Some prayers, like the prayer of faith and the prayer of agreement, you pray one time and that is it.

The prayer of supplication

Although the prayer of faith and the prayer of an agreement is very important and powerful prayers, we have almost forgotten about prayers that can be prayed over and over again.

This prayer in First Timothy 2, was for men (people), not money.

- Supplication prayer trusts in God and has faith in God, for what He can do

When we want favor with people, and if they have a policy that would keep them from giving us what we want, they would be willing to change it in our favor.

We have to first write the prayer out. Because the first word, supplication, meant "petition."

If we were going to write the petition we would have to write it like a legal document as if to the city, the state, or the U. S. government.

We want to write out our prayer in the form of a legal petition.

Every time we made a statement, we will have a corresponding Scripture reference in the margin. Sometimes we included the references within the petition.

We have to search the Scriptures to find the promises for what we were asking, The scripture and the need have to be based on the same thing.



God is the Highest God.

He is the Supreme Judge of the universe. The judge that decrees a thing and pass judgement on it.

Jesus, you have an Advocate, He is the Lawyer who pleads your case. He uses the words you speak to plead your case.

The Holy Spirit, who is the sheriff, is an enforcer making sure God's Word is carried out on the earth.

Knowing the will of God in a particular area, give you faith to speak it, write it and command it, when we turn all things over to the Trinity they say Yes when men say No, allowing you to move forward as they make it happen.
